EXHIBITOR PARKING: There's specified exhibitor parking in the grounds of the BMAC. After unloading/unpacking, vehicles will be required to be parked in the Exhibitor Parking space for the duration of the markets. A copy of the market & parking areas will be supplied.

VISITOR PARKING: Both Disabled and non-disabled parking will be available.

HOW MANY STALLS ARE THERE? – Max of 40 stallholders with limits on each category to ensure stallholder returns and variety for the customers. Stall holder positions will be emailed to you monthly in the week prior to the market. Long term stallholders will have first preference on stall location. You need to provide a copy of your current public liability insurance, a completed stallholder agreement and be approved before paying the FEES and being accepted as an exhibitor. Please also supply your stall dimensions so we can ensure there is no overlapping.

CATEGORIES: No more than the following stalls in any one category to be promoted to ensure you receive max patronage. Categories are as follows:

- 2 wineries/brewery (tastings and full bottle purchases only – no drinking on site. Exhibitors must carry and display a current license from Liquor licensing)
- 6 x seasonal producers i.e. Dragon fruit, strawberries etc.
- 2 x olives/oil
- 4 x flowers/plants
- 8 x value added e.g. Pantry, Pasta, Jams, Chutneys, Preserves, Nuts, Teas, Lollies, Jerky etc.
- 10 x Hand Made wood, visual art, jewellery, sculpture etc.
- 4 x Hand Made products such as soaps, shampoos, skin care etc.
- 4 other

INFRASTRUCTURE: Market stall holders would be responsible for all infrastructure and insurances.

BUSKING: A Busking spot for entertainment will be offered.

COSTS: Stallholder fees are to pay for the insurance on the grounds, marketing, organisation and promotion of the markets. All profits from these fees will go to Youngcare.

STALL FEES: The fee is Casual stallholders \$30.00 per market or Permanent Stallholders \$20 per market prepaid 3 months in advance and to be taken consecutively from payment.

POWER: As the exhibitors will be spread across the grounds, power will not be offered as a rule. If you require power or would like to offer our guests a more enhanced experience, power will be available to limited site locations and be an additional cost of \$20 per market.

All applications must meet the following criteria to ensure our Vision is upheld:

- High/total stallholder involvement in production of saleable items
- Good/great presentation and customer service
- Product must be at least 60% handmade and of high quality
- Localness - stallholders are encouraged to source their produce as locally as practical
- Stallholders are encouraged to have strong ideals on their environmental practices for the production and sale of their product.
- No 2nd hand products will be accepted.

We're looking at building a reputation on the ethos of locally made, high quality, fresh regional, seasonal, locally owned and made products. The key to our success is the collective all believing the same ethos.

Please note the following conditions in relation to all applications received:

1. All applications are subject to the details in the stallholder agreement (see attached)
2. If your application is accepted only the products/services listed in your application form may be sold at the Bunya Mountains Market.
3. Proof of your involvement and the localness of your products/services may be required
4. Final approval of all applications is the decision of BMAC management
5. BMAC reserves the right to determine and direct the site allocation. The stall holders accept the decision of BMAC in its absolute discretion, is final and binding. BMAC reserves the right for final approval of all applications
6. You will need to provide copies of all certificates and licenses legally required i.e. Public Liability, Alcohol license (if applicable) etc.
7. The assessment of applications may take up to two weeks.

If your Expression of Interest is successful, you will be contacted to complete a stallholder agreement to include copies of applicable licenses and insurances.
